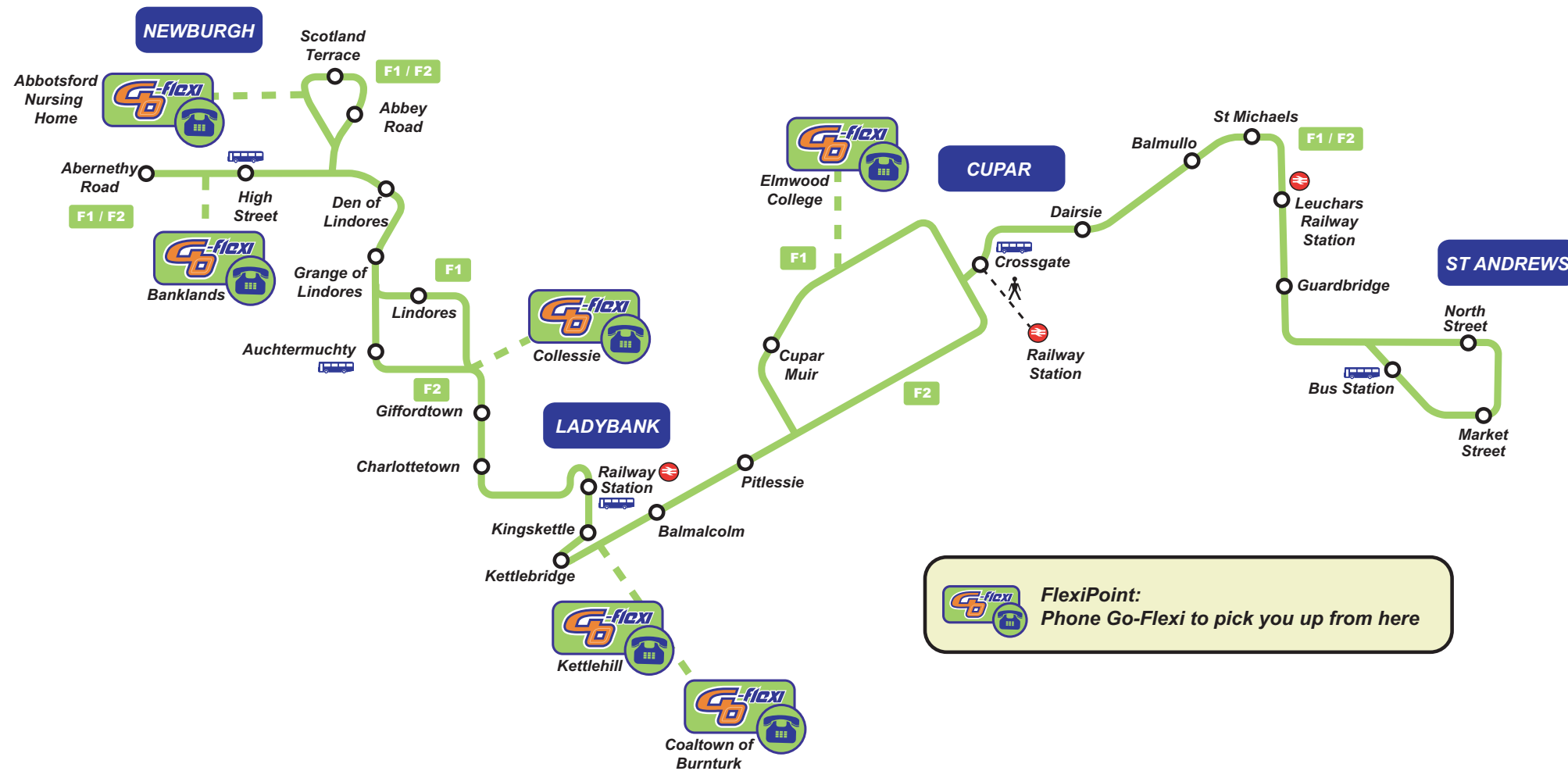


Go-Flexi Services F1 & F2 run from Newburgh to St Andrews via many villages in between. They're normal bus services with a fixed timetable and use normal bus stops along their routes. But, by phoning Go-Flexi in advance, you can divert Services F1 & F2 from their normal routes to call at additional, nearby villages or 'FlexiPoints', as we call them.

If you want picked-up at a FlexiPoint, you simply call Go-Flexi at least 1 hour before you want to travel. You will be given an estimated pick-up time for your FlexiPoint based on the timetable for the normal route. If you want dropped-off at a FlexiPoint, you don't need to phone at all - you simply tell the driver where you want to go when you board the bus. **There's no need to phone if you want to go to/from a point on the normal route.** Only phone if you need picked-up from a FlexiPoint. Depending on the number of FlexiPoints visited on each journey, journeys may run up to 10 minutes later than timetabled.

Routes: (FlexiPoints are shown in blue)

Newburgh (Abernethy Road, Woodriffie Road, Banklands, Woodriffie Road, High Street) THEN EITHER (Melville Place, Robertson Crescent, Lyall Place, Shorehead, Gardens Road, Shorehead, Lyall Place, Robertson Crescent, Scotland Terrace, Abbey Road) OR (Cupar Road) THEN A913, Den of Lindores, B936, Grange of Lindores THEN EITHER F2 : B936, Auchtermuchty (Newburgh Road, Distillery Street, Burnside, Cupar Road), A91 OR F1: Lindores, B937 THEN F1/F2: Collessie, B937, Giffordtown, Charlottetown, unclassified road, B938, Ladybank (Monkstown, Church Street, Melville Road, Victoria Street, Railway Station, Commercial Crescent, Kettle Road), Kingskettle (Ladybank Road, Main Street, South Street), Kettlebridge (Rumdewan, Back Park, Cupar Road), Kettlehill, Coaltown of Burmturk, A914, Pitlessie (Cupar Road), A914, Clushford Toll, THEN EITHER F1: unclassified road, Cupar Muir (Cupar Road), Cupar (Brighton Road, Elmwood College, Millbank, Millgate) OR F2: A914, Cupar (South Road, South Bridge) THEN Crossgate, St Catherine Street, East Bridge, East Road, A91, Dairsie, A914, Balmullo (Pitcairn Road, Cynicus Place, School Road, Hayston Park, Main Road), A914, St Michaels, A919, Leuchars Station, A919, Guardbridge (Main Street, Cupar Road), A91, St Andrews (Pilmour Links, City Road, Bus Station). Return journeys operate from the Bus Station via City Road, Market Street, Union Street, North Street, Pilmour Links and reverse of outward route.

If you want picked-up from a FlexiPoint, call Go-Flexi at least 1 hour before travelling. Lines are open Monday to Saturday, 0620 until 2100. FlexiPoint pick-ups may be booked up to 1 week in advance.
